Dear Ann Harris Bennett, Harris County Tax Assessor-Collector & Voter Registrar:

The Harris County Auditor's Office - Compliance Audit performed procedures relative to the Harris County Tax Assessor-Collector's vehicle taxes and fees monthly collection reports for the six months ended, March 31, 2024. As required by Local Government Code §115.002 (a) and (b), Compliance Audit selectively examined the financial activity relative to the vehicle taxes and fees monthly collection reports and related records.

The objectives of the engagement were to determine whether:

- The amounts reflected on the monthly collection reports of vehicle taxes and fees were properly deposited with the Harris County Treasurer's Office;
- Monthly vehicle taxes and fee collection reports were accurately stated; and
- Voided transactions were properly approved by a supervisor.

Results

In connection with the procedures performed, no reportable issues were noted.

We conducted our audit in accordance with the International Standards for the Professional Practice of Internal Auditing (Standards). The Standards require that we comply with the Code of Ethics and obtain reasonable assurance that significant risks to the activity are minimized to an acceptable level.
